ASQ-TRAK2: Improvement and extension of a culturally safe and appropriate developmental screening tool.

With support from the Department of Social Services (DSS) Early childhood Targeted Action Plan, we are working to fill existing gaps in culturally appropriate developmental screening for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander children.

This project will extend the existing ASQ-TRAK to include all 21 age intervals aligned with the mainstream Ages & Stages Questionnaires® (ASQ®-3).

This responds to the needs of stakeholders and the increasing demand for the full suite of ASQ-TRAK age intervals.



## What's new?

- All 21 age intervals from the ASQ<sup>®</sup>-3 14 more ages than the ASQ-TRAK.
- Amended illustrations to better represent the diversity among Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples.
- Revised questionnaires to incorporate changes to wording and terminology.
- Updated scoring tables.
- New scoring instructions for some items.
- Additional information for the caregiver and practitioner to support administration.
- The use of lighter, more durable materials.
